

NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 468

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 468 will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, April 6, 2022, at 11:30 a.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, **Suite 2400, Guadalupe Room**, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes.
3. District security matters, including Interlocal Agreement with Harris County for substation.
4. Approve Developer Reimbursement Report for Series 2021 Bonds.
5. Financial and bookkeeping matters, payment of bills and review investments, consider budget for fiscal year end May 31, 2022, and authorize disbursement of Bond proceeds.
6. Discuss transition of electricity charges for Vintage Royale street lights to District and authorize appropriate action.
7. Tax assessment and collections matters, including:
 - a. payment of tax bills; and
 - b. delinquent tax collections and installment agreements.
8. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. authorize design of facilities;
 - b. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for District facilities;
 - c. update on construction of the Chasewood waterline loop;
 - d. receive update on construction of facilities to serve development in the District and approve pay estimates, time extensions, change orders and final acceptance, as appropriate, for construction of District facilities, including outfall repair along Cypress Creek;
 - e. easements, deeds, plats, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters;
 - f. annexation matters; and
 - g. authorize capacity allocation audit.
9. Annexation matters, including:
 - a. adopt Order Adding Land and authorize execution of Amendment to Information Form; and
 - b. accept Waiver of Special Appraisal.
10. Maintenance of District facilities, including:
 - a. update on maintenance of Vintage Royale Detention Pond and Vintage Royale Amenity Pond, including proposals for maintenance;

- b. discuss and consider Storm Water Solutions' price increase and authorize appropriate action; and
 - c. update on maintenance of regional detention pond.
 - 11. Update on park and recreation facility projects, including:
 - a. construction and maintenance of landscaping and irrigation in the District;
 - b. development and maintenance of regional parks in the District; and
 - c. review bids and award contract for construction of District Recreational Trail, Phase 1.
 - 12. Report regarding development in the District.
 - 13. District website matters.
 - 14. Conduct annual review and receive report from operator on Identity Theft Prevention Program and adopt Identity Theft Prevention Program Amendment.
 - 15. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs and maintenance, including:
 - a. water accountability;
 - b. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service; and
 - c. amend Rate Order.
